DISCLOSURE OF RISKS WHILST PARTICIPATING IN ACTIVITIES AT SEP UK

Your child is applying to attend the Summer Educational Programme UK at Loch Lomond. One of the main aims of the camp and the programme is to introduce and encourage activities that can have lasting benefits for young people with regard to their future health and development – some of these activities include adventure activities. These activities can provide a healthy and safe outlet for excitement and challenge from which many young people can benefit.

However, adventure activities themselves are not completely free from risk. Whilst the chances of serious injury are extremely remote, the chance of minor injury has to be seen as an unwelcome but possible eventuality. We fully accept our legal and moral responsibilities in these matters. Through training and best practice, including following all current HSE guidelines, our staff strives to be vigilant at all times in the safety and protection of children in the challenge programme environment.

During SEP, we have a qualified first aid team on site whose collective skills can deal with matters of first aid whether physical or emotional. All our campers and staff are temporarily registered with the local GP to whom more serious matters are referred. Emergency matters are referred immediately to the local hospital Accident & Emergency unit. We will notify you immediately should this occur.
